Selection Guidelines for Senior Cricket 2006

The basis of the below guidelines is to make everyone fully aware of their duties to the club. The purpose is to maintain the social/friendly spirit of the Beaconsfield Cricket Club, but at the same time make the playing members aware of their individual responsibilities to the smooth efficient running of the club. Through your co operation we can ensure the continued success of all cricket sides at Beaconsfield.

Beaconsfield Committee – May 2006

- To play cricket for Beaconsfield Cricket Club for the 2006 season members must pay the appropriate subscription before 31st May 2006, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Club Committee. **Failure to pay annual subs will lead to non-selection.**
- Unless due to extraordinary circumstances an incoming player will not be selected directly into the Beaconsfield 1st XI; the player will begin their playing season in a club side below this.
- Selection of all sides will in normal circumstances be completed by Wednesday. The selectors/captains must make themselves available to discuss any issues with team members either individually or as a group prior to Wednesday every week during the season.
- To be available for the 1st XI selection for the Saturday, players must make every effort to be available for practice on Tuesday and Thursday each week. Practices commence at 6.15pm and will usually be completed by 7.45pm. It is recognised that playing members can not always attend practice, but every effort should be made to attend. All other playing members are encouraged to train regularly on Thursday evenings.
- Any 1st XI absences from practice must be communicated to the captain prior to the practice.
- Players in all sides will be selected for teams based on practice and ethic, performances and attitudes.
- If, due to form, or other extenuating circumstances, a player is omitted from the 1st XI side when available, he must be selected for the 2nd XI side if available. This policy is applicable for other sides also.
- 1st XI selection is made by Sam Musk as captain with Richard Holdsworth and Steve Lynch being available in an advisory capacity. If for any reason Sam Musk is unavailable to captain the 1st XI, a replacement shall be chosen from the side selected.
- 2nd XI selection is made by Geoff Watts as captain with Sam Musk, Jon Mahood and Steve Lynch being available in an advisory capacity. If for any reason Geoff Watts is unavailable to captain the 2nd XI, a replacement shall be chosen from the side selected.
- 3rd XI selection is made by Dan Gowers as captain with Jon Mahood and Chris Mann being available in an advisory capacity. If for any reason Dan Gowers is unavailable to captain the 3rd XI, a replacement shall be chosen from the side selected.
- Jon Mahood will be responsible for over-seeing all selection meetings with the relevant captains and for ensuring the selection email is distributed, ideally by midday on Wednesday. Members must reply to the availability email or contact their captain by midday on Tuesday otherwise they risk non-selection.
- Whenever a player is promoted or dropped from a side then they will first be called by the captain of the team they are leaving; they will then be welcomed to their new side by the captain of that team.
